

Driver's Education Registration

Students who have completed the 8th grade are eligible to sign up for the Driver's Education training offered this summer at Northern Cass. The ND DPI requires 30 hours of classroom time and 6 hours of behind the wheel for students to earn a ¼ credit towards graduation. This also meets the requirement for acquiring a minor's driver's license at the age of 15. We will hold two sessions if necessary. The dates for the first classroom session will be May 28, 29, 30, June 3, 4. The second classroom session, if needed, will run on June 5, 6, 7, 13, 14. The time will be from 8:00-2:00 each day. If there are less than 10 students that sign up for either session we will only hold the session that has the most students registered. Students may want to bring a sack lunch as the school will not be providing lunch.

The cost is \$200.00 which includes the classroom and behind the wheel training. This can be paid to Northern Cass School when registering or at the beginning of the classroom session. Students are responsible for their own transportation to and from the school during their classroom session. Students will also need to schedule two or three days for their behind the wheel training time. This scheduling will be done during their classroom session. When students are doing their behind the wheel training, I can pick the student up and drop them off at their home or make other arrangements with parent permission.
