On Wednesday, March 20th, sophomores will be taking the ASVAB (Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery). This assessment will help learners be better prepared to make decisions towards their choice ready pathways while moving through high school. Learners, regardless of interests in military options, can learn more about their skills, interests, values, and explore occupations based on those results.

The assessment focuses on 8 areas - General Science, Arithmetic Reasoning, Word Knowledge, Paragraph Comprehension, Mathematics Knowledge, Electronics Information, Auto & Shop Information, and Mechanical Comprehension.

To prepare for this assessment, be sure to get a good night's sleep and be sure to eat prior to testing.

Testing will take place in the school library starting at 8:30am. Please be at the school before 8:20am. If you do not want to have your learner take this assessment please notify the school (Mr. Margerum) before next Wednesday.

We are planning to have the results be interpreted and reviewed with learners during the morning of April 10th.
